

Exam Exemption Policy

2014

To be eligible for an exemption, students must meet all of the following criteria:

- No more than six (6) Excused absences (code E) in any course
 - No Unexcused (code U) absences in any course
- Note: Curriculum field trips and other school related activities (coded ACT) and special circumstances absences (coded SC) are excluded from absences.
- Completed All Major tests and Major pieces of evaluation in each of the courses in which s/he is enrolled
 - NEVER been suspended from school during the semester
 - Students must have ALL of their teacher's signatures on the exemption form to qualify for an exemption
 - Student's must have their parent /guardian's signature on the exemption form to qualify for an exemption

Students are permitted to exempt **one** exam each semester if they meet ALL of the criteria listed above.

Courses that are **NOT** eligible for exemption are: Process exams, English 10, English 11, Advanced English 11, English Communications 11, English 12, Advanced English 12, English Communications 12, Mathematics at Work 10, Mathematics 10, Mathematics 11, Advanced Mathematics 11, Mathematics 12, Pre-Calculus 12, Calculus 12

Please note: Students who have qualified for exemptions under the attendance criteria have had their names posted outside the guidance office. This does not qualify students for an exemption, as they still must meet all other exemption criteria. If students have questions regarding the attendance criteria they must see their Vice Principal or Guidance Counselor by Wednesday January 15th at 3:30 pm.
